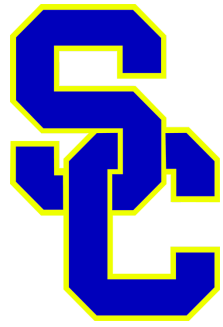


Scott City Rams Athletic and Activities Covid-19 Protocol 2020-2021



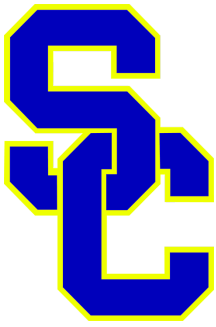
The following protocols will be put into place during the 2020-2021 school year. The Scott City Jr./Sr. Administration will closely monitor and be in contact with the Scott County Department and MSHSAA as the situation changes and base the best practices and protocols on the recommendation of the health department, state government, and MSHSAA.

Jr./Sr. High Volleyball and Basketball Home Games

- Both sides of bleachers will be pulled out to help with social distancing at every home game. Fans will need to practice social distancing unless near family members.
- Fans will be reminded about social distancing (signs) and on game time sound systems. Fans will be encouraged to wear face coverings and will only be required to if the Local Health Department or State government mandates it.
- Workers (Supervision, Gate, concessions) will wear face coverings while on duty.
- Concessions will only offer pre-packaged food and drinks.
 - Workers will use masks and gloves.
 - Hand disinfectant will be available for all.
- Coaches and players on the bench not participating during the games are required to wear a face covering per MSHSAA recommendation and guidelines.

Cross Country and Football

- Fans are encouraged to bring lawn chairs for football games.
- Home and visiting bleachers will be available. Fans will need to social distance unless near family members.
- Workers (Supervision, Gate, concessions, etc) will wear face masks while on duty.
- Concessions will only offer pre-packaged food and drinks.
 - Workers will use masks and gloves
 - Hand disinfectant will be available for all
- Coaches and players on the sidelines, not participating during the games are required to wear a face covering per MSHSAA recommendation and guidelines.
- Cross Country meets protocols and procedures will be determined by the host school

and the information will be given out as it becomes available.

- Band will perform behind the endzone to accommodate for social distancing during varsity football games.
- If there is a restriction on social gatherings mandated by the local health department or state government, the following protocol will be in placed:
 - Tier 1 (Essential): Participants, Coaches/Directors, Officials, Event Staff, Medical Staff, Security
 - Tier 2 (Preferred): Media
 - Tier 3 (Non-essential): Spectators (Family of students), vendors, and non family spectators.
- As situations change, more restrictions may need to be applied and will be communicated to families and visiting teams.
